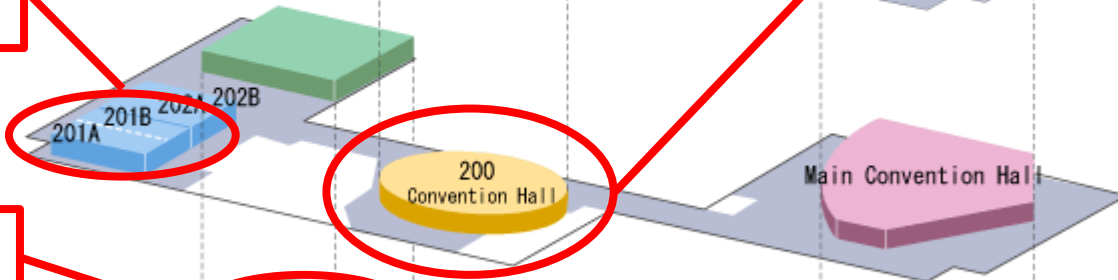

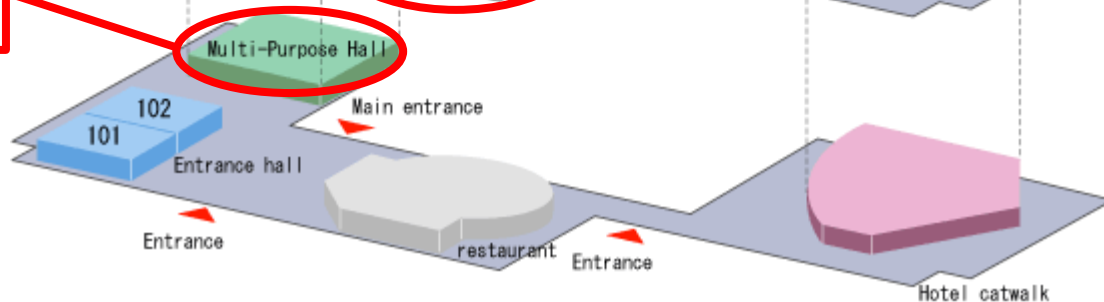
Plenary Sessions

Registration Desk / Conference Secretariat

- Registration desk in front of the 200 convention hall (plenary sessions) will open until 10:45, today.
- The registration desk will be moved to the conference secretariat at Room 401 after 10:45, today.

Lunch / Coffee
