

# Haneda to KEK

# 1. Taxi

It takes about 3 hours from Haneda to KEK. The fare is around 32,000 yen including the high way fee. Some taxis accept major credit cards. Taxi stands are located on the ground floor (1F), outside of the building. FYI, the arrival lobby is on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor (2F) of the building.

# 2. Bus


It takes 2.5 hours or more depending on the traffic.

From Haneda Airport International Terminal to Tsukuba Center

Please purchase a ticket for "Tsukuba Center" from the "Bus Tickets Counter" at Arrival lobby(2F) or "Bus Ticket Vending Machine" on the ground floor (1F). The bus fare is 1,850 yen.

Terminal Bus Stop: Ground Floor (1F), outside of the building



The buses to "Tsukuba Center" leaves from the #9 bus stop on the map.

\* Several buses to different destinations share the same bus stop. Please be sure to check the destination sign before you get on.



#### Another option is to take a local bus.

Please take the "Tsuku bus [Hokubu Shuttle] (つくバス-北部シャトル)" at No. 3 bus stop at Tsukuba Center. The fare is 300 yen. There is no pre-purchased ticket for "Tsuku-bus". Please pay for it when you get off. The bus stop for KEK is "Koh-enerugi-kasokuki-kenkyu-kiko (高エネルギー加速器研究機構)".

# 3. Train

It takes about 2.5 hours.

### From Haneda Airport International Terminal to Tsukuba

You will need to change trains twice. The instruction is as below.

#### <Tickets>

Tickets can be bought from ticket vending machines around the gates. However, we recommend purchasing prepaid transportation IC card, "PASMO", which can be used mainly around Tokyo area. It can be used for almost all trains and local buses.

\* How to get a PASMO \*

Where: Train ticketing counters / Train ticket vending machines

Cost: 500 yen as deposit. And you top up from minimum 1,000yen till maximum 10,000 yen.

Going to KEK costs about 3,000 yen each way.

The deposit and the amount of money left in the IC card will be refunded when you return the card to the train ticketing counters.



### (a) At Haneda Airport International Terminal

Please take the **Keikyu Line** which is located on the first floor (2F Arrival lobby). And please take any trains **EXCEPT** for the ones are down for Kanazawabunko "金沢文庫", Sengakuji "泉岳寺" or Shin-Zushi "新逗子". Then change the train at **Shinagawa Station**.

<<For those who purchase a ticket>>
Please purchase a connection ticket for "Akihabara" of JR line(580yen) from Keikyu line's vending machine.

#### (b) At Shinagawa Station

Please follow the "Transfer to JR Lines" signs on the platform, change to Yamanote Line "山手線" (Tokyo, Ueno direction) and get off at Akihabara Station.

#### (c) At Akihabara Station

Please go out of the JR Station, then follow the sign and go to the gates for Tsukuba Express Line "つくばエクスプレス"(See below). Take any train bound for Tsukuba and get off at the last stop Tsukuba Station.


